DISCUSSION ON THE MEDIATOR

- Who does the debtor represent? (Each of us.)
- What does the creditor represent? (The laws of justice.)
- Who does the debtor's friend represent? (Jesus Christ.)
- We knew we would make mistakes. Sins are those mistakes and are like the debt in the story.
- Jesus was sinless, and so could meet the demands of justice completely
 - Becomes the new creditor, to be repaid on his terms. What are those terms?
